Pool Rules

Pool Rules

- Showers are required before entering the water
- No diving in the shallow end of the swimming pool and other areas marked "NO DIVING".
- No running on the deck.
- No horseplay in or around the swimming pool.
- No pushing, fighting, dunking, or other rough play in or around the aquatic facility.
- All food and drink must be kept in the concession area, except plastic bottles with lids.
- The height requirement for the tower waterslides is 48 inches.
- If asked by staff, patrons must demonstrate the ability to swim one length of the pool to earn a deep water pass. The deep water pass allows patrons to use the diving well area, board and drop slide.
- Coast Guard-approved lifejackets and floatation devices are allowed only when kept within an arm's length of an attendant over the age of 16.
- Balls are not allowed. Water toys will be subject to the approval of the manager on duty.
- Strollers are permitted. However, they must not block a pedestrian walkway.

For your safety, the following is NOT permitted

- Throwing items in such a manner that may risk injury.
- Balls, snorkels, noodles, inflatable tubes, air mattresses, squirt bottles, or squirt guns, during open swim unless permitted by the manager.
- Glass containers of any kind.
- Profanity.
- Weapons of any kind.

Pool Rules Continued

Slide Rules

- Slide riders must be at least 48" tall.
- One rider at a time, no exceptions.
- Rider must wait for the attendant's signal before starting.
- Slide feet first in a laying or sitting position.
- After entering the pool, exit promptly.
- Swimwear with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets, or metal ornamentation is prohibited.
- Eyeglasses must be securely affixed to the rider with a head strap.
- Pregnant women and any person with heart condition or back trouble should not ride the slide.
- Water depth in the pool is 3 ft. 6 in.

Diving Board and Deep Water Rules

For safety reasons, the Glidden Aquatic Center requires that all swimmers/divers using the deep end, must be able to swim. We ask all patrons to please use caution when using the deep water area and know your limitations. For the safety of all patrons, the following deep end rules are enforced:

- If asked by staff, patrons must demonstrate the ability to swim one length of the pool to earn their deep water pass.
- Parents are not allowed to catch children or assist children in swimming to the side in any way. If a parent is needed to aid a child, the child is more than likely not able to demonstrate the 25 m. swim test and should not be allowed in the deep water.
- Only one person on the board at a time.
- Before diving, check that the person in the water is at the side of the pool.
- Once in the pool, exit promptly to the side steps nearest the board.
- Divers are allowed only one bounce on the board.
- Swimming is not allowed in the deep water when diving and the drop slide are available.

- In the event of threatening weather or cool temperatures, management may close the Glidden Aquatic Center. Re-opening of the facility is at the discretion of the management on duty. Rain checks are not given in the event the facility must close.
- Patrons are not permitted to bring food or drink into the facility. The City reserves the right to inspect baggage or carry-in parcels.
- The Glidden Aquatic Center reserves the right to refuse admittance to, or eject from the aquatic center premises, any person failing to comply with rules for the health and safety of the patrons of the Glidden Aquatic Center.
- Any person suspected of being under the influence of a controlled substance will not be admitted, and law enforcement personnel will be summoned.
- The Glidden Aquatic Center is a tobacco-free facility.
- The paging of patrons at the Aquatic Center is allowed only in emergency situations. Please make necessary communicative arrangements prior to separating your group at the facility.
- The City of Glidden is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Showers are required before entering the pool.
- It is the responsibility of the patron to read and obey all posted signs and rules of the Glidden Aquatic Center.
- Everyone who enters the Aquatic Center must pay the appropriate fee or present an authorized season membership, regardless of his or her intention to swim.
- Limited pass outs are permitted; please have your hand stamped at the admissions counter.
- Appropriate swim attire must be worn. Thongs or cutoffs are not allowed. Swimsuits or other attire with zippers or ornamentation will not be allowed on slides.
- Swim diapers are required for children not yet toilet trained.
- Children 9 years and younger must be supervised at all times by a person at least 16 years of age.
